CATEGORIES:**SENIOR A LADIES/MEN (ISU Judging System)**

The required elements in accordance with ISU Technical Rules (611 and 612) and the valid ISU Communications (2186) and later.

JUNIOR A LADIES/MEN (ISU Judging System)

The required elements in accordance with ISU Technical Rules (611 and 612) and the valid ISU Communications (2186) and later.

However, in addition, in Junior A, Ladies short program a triple jump is required.

NOVICE A, GIRLS AND BOYS, born 1.7.2003 or later
ISU Judging System according to the Finnish rules of SM-Noviiit.

Short Program: **Duration:** **Girls/Boys:** 2 min 20 secs +/- 10 sec

Vocal music is allowed.

1. Double Axel

(in case skater does not attempt 2A or executes 1A or A, the jump will be marked * (no value)

2. Double or triple jump**3. 1 jump combination (with two double jumps or double jump and triple jump)**

- solo jumps may not be repeated

4. Spins:

- Girls: Layback spin (sideways and/or backwards) or upright or camel or sit spin with min 6 revs. You may not start the spin with the jump.
- Boys: A spin (camel, sit, upright) with one position with one change of foot min 5 revs. on both feet. You may not start the spin with the jump.
- **One spin combination** with only one change of foot and at least one change of position min 5 revs. on both feet. Spin may start with a jump.

5. 1 step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Bonus: - double Axel: +1.0
 - triple jump: +2.0
 - 2 different triple jumps: + 4.0

Maximum bonus is 4.0 points.

All program component factors are 0.7 (Girls) and 0.8 (Boys).

Deduction/fall is 0.5 points.

Base value for the last jump element (1) executed after the first half of the program will be multiplied with 1.1.

- Deduction for missing/wrong spiral will be 0.5 points each. (if spiral is not attempted or leg doesn't rise above pelvis or spiral is not on edge or duration is less than 3 secs.)

All program component factors are 1.3.

Deduction/fall is 0.5 points.

DEBUTANTS A GIRLS, born 1.7.2005 or later **ISU Judging System according to the Finnish rules of Debytantit**

Free Skate: **Duration:** **Girls:** 3 min +/- 10 sec
Vocal music is allowed.

1. Max **6** jump elements
 - One must be an Axel jump.
 - Max. 2 jump combinations or jump sequences of which only 1 jump combination may consist of 3 jumps.
 - Only two jumps with 3 revs. or more, may be repeated in a jump combination or jump sequence.
 - Each single and double jump, including 1A and 2A, can be repeated only twice. (they don't have to be in a jump combination or jump sequence).
 - There should be 4 different double jumps in the program (not required).
2. Max. **2** different spins
 - **One spin combination** (CoSp or CCoSp) with or without change of foot (min 8 revs). The spin may not start with a jump.
 - **Flying spin or spin with flying entry** in one position (camel, sit or upright) with one foot (min 5 revs) or with change of foot (min 8 revs).
3. 1 step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.
4. Min. **2** spirals, both on the edge and one must last at least 3 secs.
 - The spirals cannot be included in the step sequence.
 - Spirals will be evaluated in transitions.
 - Deduction for missing/wrong spiral will be 0.5 points each (if spiral is not attempted or leg doesn't rise above pelvis or spiral is not on edge or duration is less than 3 secs.)

Bonus: - double Axel: +1.0
 - triple jump: +2.0
 - 2 different triple jumps: + 4.0

Maximum bonus is 4.0 points.

All program component factors are 1.3.

Deduction/fall is 0.5 points.

SPRINGS B GIRLS, born 2007 or later **Finnish Extended Star Evaluation according to the Finnish rules of B-Silmut**

Free Skate: **Duration:** 2 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec
Vocal music is allowed.

1. Maximum of **5** jump elements
 - One must be an Axel type of jump.
 - Maximum of 2 jump combinations or jump sequences (one jump combination with 3 jumps, one with max 2 jumps).
 - Each single and double jump, including 1A or 2A, can be repeated only twice. (they don't have to be in a jump combination or jump sequence).

- The program should contain 1 double jump (not required), but all double jumps can be attempted.
2. Maximum of 2 different spins, each with different abbreviations.
 - One spin combination with or without change of foot (min. 8 revs.) The spin may not start with a jump.
 - One position spin on one foot (min 5 revs), with change of foot (min. 8 revs.). The spin may start with a jump.
 3. 1 step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.
 4. Minimum of 2 unsupported spirals, both on edge and one must last at least 3 secs. Evaluated in steps, spirals and transitions (Finnish Extended Star Evaluation). May not include in a step sequence.

0.5 points deduction /no or wrong spiral each.

Time deduction: 0.5 points/every 5 sec.

NOTE:

If time permits, we will add the Cubs-category (FS) on Friday, February 1, 2019. A separate invitation will be sent to selected clubs in case this category will be added.

CUBS GIRLS, born 2009 or later

Finnish Extended Star Evaluation according to the Finnish rules of Minit

Free Skating:

Duration: max 2 min 30 sec

Vocal music is allowed.

1. 5 jumps, max 2 jump combinations/sequences
 - max 2 double jumps may be done or attempted (ie 2x2T or 1x2S and 1x2T)
 - max 1 combination with 3 jumps, the other with 2 jumps
2. 3 spins
3. 1 step sequence covering at least 1/2 of the skating area.
4. 2 unsupported spirals.

0.5 points deduction for every missing spiral, maximum deduction -1.0.

Time deduction: 0.5 points/every 5 sec.
